Hello École Joe Clark Families,

We wanted to inform you about some upcoming changes to our school parking lot aimed at improving student safety during arrival and dismissal times.

Due to the gates being locked by the nearby Housing Co-Op—and despite our efforts to collaborate on a long-term solution—we are making adjustments on our end to ensure students can move safely between the front and back of the school.

This week, our maintenance team will be creating a designated pathway along the west side of the parking lot (next to the brick wall on the east side of the school). This pathway will be clearly marked with fencing and signage to guide students and families. We kindly ask that families use this pathway when dropping off or picking up students on the east side of the building. For safety reasons, students and families should not walk through the parking lot—please model safe practices by using the designated path.

Please note the following changes:

- Accessible parking will be reduced to two spaces, which aligns with current guidelines and
 meets our school's needs. These spaces will remain available for students who require
 accessible pick-up and drop-off.
- **Garbage and recycling bins** will be relocated to the playground area and enclosed with fencing to ensure student safety.
- The parking lot will remain reserved for FSD staff only, aside from the accessible parking spaces. We ask that families respect this and arrange alternative drop-off or pick-up locations around the school.

We understand that parking has been a challenge, and we appreciate your ongoing patience and support. If your children are older, we encourage you to establish a meeting spot closer to the west end of the school, such as near the park or lake parking area.

Thank you for your understanding as we work to create a safer and more efficient environment for everyone. If you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to reach out.
