Ecole Joe Clark Junior Kindergarten Program

We will be offering full day program options for next year.

- Monday/ Wednesday Program, option of adding Friday
- Tuesday Thursday Program, option of adding Friday
- Hours are 9am 3pm

English Kindergarten Program

- Monday/Wednesday and additional Fridays
- Option to access JK Programming on non-kinder days

French Immersion Kindergarten Program

- Monday-Friday, Full Day Program
- Fee is \$250.00 per month

Our French Immersion programming will be full time for next year (Monday to Friday), our English Kindergarten will remain part time (Monday/Wednesday). Students in English kindergarten will have the option of accessing Junior Kindergarten on their non kindergarten days. This additional add on is an additional cost to families but does provide extra learning activities and can support a student's progress by offering many social-emotional and play based learning opportunities. All our Early Learning programs are offered based on registrations received, so please register your child early to avoid disappointment.

<u>Jr Kindergarten, English Kindergarten and Fl Kindergarten Registration and Info Night</u> will be held on February 1 from 6:00-7:30pm. Please feel free to come ask questions and register online from the school.

French Immersion Program will also be holding an FI Information evening on February 13 from 6-7pm. Please plan to attend if you have questions about enrolling your child in the program and wish to discuss with our FI team. We would be accepting registrations for students who are entering Kindergarten and Grade One for next year.
