What is Carnaval?

Carnaval is a lively and colorful celebration that takes place in various parts of the world. Held in Quebec City, Canada, the Quebec Winter Carnival (French: Carnaval de Québec) is a pre-Lenten festival that has been celebrated annually since 1955. The carnival typically occurs between late January and mid-February. During this 10-day extravaganza, the city transforms into a snow festival adorned with decorations, ice sculptures, and lights. There are often colorful float parades showcasing artistic and thematic designs and live music performances add to the festive atmosphere.

Beyond Quebec, Carnaval traditions thrive in other French-speaking regions, from the sunny streets of Nice, France, to the smoked herring launches in Dunkerque.

In Canada's North Bay, Ontario, the Carnaval des Compagnons echoes Quebec's spirit, bringing snowy activities and caribou drinks to the Francophone community.
