

We are offering Full Time (full days M-F) kindergarten at 4 school sites:



To apply:

When you register online, you will have the option to select either 'Part Time' or 'Full Time' kindergarten.

*Selecting 'Full Time' is your way of indicating you are interested in full-time kindergarten. It does not mean a guarantee of a fulltime program in September. We will connect with all families by Mid-May to indicate if we have enough children registered to run!







Kindergarten only: If you live 2.4 km or farther from your designated school (for students in K-3 without siblings, or K-3 students with an older sibling in the same school), you may qualify for busing.

How you can help your child get ready for school

- Read books together every single day and point to the
- Develop fine motor skills (how to hold a pencil, use scissors, play with playdough)
- Practice letters and letter recognition
- Find letters/numbers in the environment
- Count with concrete items (toys, rocks, Lego)
- Build your child's self esteem with praise, hugs and
- Help your child take responsibility (cleaning up toys, using the bathroom, getting their own healthy snacks)





Alberta Health Services provides Speech Language (SLP), Occupational Therapy (OT) and Physiotherapy consultations and support for children aged 0-5.






