Highlights in an overview:

- Reduced reserves, down to 3.1 %, FSD does not have the ability to reduce the burden on schools and reduce the class sizes compared to previous years with additional teachers where needed.
- Property insurance went up 400% to 2 Mio\$ per year
- 30 fewer teachers, FSD lost roughly 1 teacher per school
- Reduced staff in the in the head offices (30)
- Parents should reach out to their MLA FSD will provide a letter
- Parents have the greatest voice, so call and make yourself heard
- Would love to offer a town hall meeting for parents to ask all their questions
- FSD Trustee Report Teresa Letendre (in lieu of Jack Molyneux)
