Our primary modes of communication will be email and phone. We reply to all issues, questions and concerns brought forward by parents. When we know of a concern, we can often find solutions and resolutions quickly, and collaboratively solve problems. Classroom teachers may use additional communication means.

COMMUNICATION HOURS & PROCEDURES

We welcome calls and emails from 6:30 am to 6:30 pm as per Appendix B in AP414. We aim to reply to non-urgent messages within 48 hours. Please note on our website calendar times the school is closed and staff are unavailable to respond to your inquiries. The primary focus of a teacher's time is interaction with students. As such, an immediate response is not possible. If you have an emergency, please contact the Main Office. Please do not text or phone your child during instructional time as cell phones are not permitted in class.

CLASSROOM COMMUNICATION

Classroom communication is an on-going two-way communication between school and home. Generally, these communications may include brief descriptions of learning in the classroom, updates of student progress, upcoming assessments and field trips. If a teacher has concerns, they will reach out by email or phone.
