 - Significant increase in the Safe and Caring Schools category vs. last year
 - Internal Resilience – across the province numbers are low % as students dealing with stress/anxiety/worry/overwhelmed etc.
 - School (Student/Staff) expectations and agreement.

 - Annual Education Results Report – Used to guide education planning based on Diploma Exam results/Provincial Achievement Test (PAT) results/Alberta Education Assurance Survey Results and FSD Assurance Survey Results (yearly survey to all parents of Foothills School Division). Allows for evidence-based decisions, guides next steps of the Division and check in with students/parents. What does the Board of Trustees do with the AERR? Look for trends and
