# French Immersion Dual Credit Course

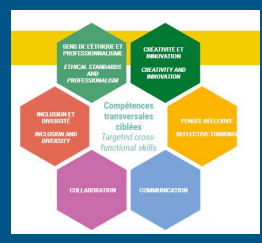
**Dual Credit – Programme d'éducation  
Provided through University of Alberta - Campus St-Jean**

**Histoire, fondements et théorie de l'apprentissage scolaire (EDU F 245)** will introduce students to the study of schools of thought and major theoretical trends that have influenced education.

### Student Eligibility

Open to **FSD French Immersion High School** students who:

- Are in Grade 11 or 12 during the program
- Are keen to experience a post-secondary course through an **online format**
- Have completed (or are on track to complete) the following pre/co-requisite courses:
  - French Language Arts 20-1 or 20-2 (minimum 80%)
  - English Language Arts 10-1 or English Language Arts 10-2 (minimum 60%)



## Program Delivery

This course is offered online, synchronous - students will meet live with their instructor during scheduled times.

## Workload

- 3 online hours/week
- 3-5 independent hours work/week

## Program Dates

- Semester 2 - February to May
  - Wednesdays, 6:00-9:00pm



## Considerations

- Online synchronous courses are live with the post-secondary instructor. They run at set times and attendance is required.
- Students must meet all course assessment deadlines in order to be successful.
- Students must be registered as a full-time student, taking at least one course at their home high school during the program (work experience excluded).
- Students will be expected to communicate with both their FSD supervising teacher and course instructor regularly.
