As we resume classes, please note:

- School Bell Times: Our day begins at 8:45 AM and ends at 3:15 PM. Please see School Bell Times at our website for our full schedule.
- Pick Up & Drop Off: Previous drop-off and pick-up routines remain in place.
- We ask that students stay outside once they arrive at school (except for inclement weather days) as our staff are preparing for their day and are not responsible for supervision inside the school at that time.
- Morning and afternoon supervision outside occurs from 8:30 am until the bell at 8:45 am, and in the afternoon from 3:15 pm- 3:30 pm.
- **Bus Lane:** The bus lane is reserved for FSD buses only. Please do not park or drop off your children in this area.
- **Parking Lot:** Our parking lot is for staff of FSD only. Parents are welcome to park in the church parking lot (they have graciously allowed us to use this in the morning) as well as at our drop and go location *right in front of the school doors*.
- If your children are older, you might consider having them meet you at the lake, as there is more parking towards the west end of the school.

- **School Fees:** The Division Office will now be assessing school and activity fees, which may result in a proration, refund, or credit, where applicable. Thank you for your patience as they work through this process as efficiently as possible.

Please make sure you dress your child in the morning warmly (hats, toques and mitts) as we attempt to get students out as much as we can!
- **Hot Lunch-** There will be NO HOT LUNCH on Friday, October 31. Hot Lunch will be up and running again over the weekend, and you can order for Friday, November 7 at that time!

As we welcome students back into the school environment, we understand that this transition may come with a mix of emotions and questions. We're here to support each child with care and compassion.

In the coming days, we'll spend time helping students readjust to the routines of school and revisit key concepts. Our priority is to ensure that every student feels safe, supported, and confident as they reconnect with their learning.
