Toys and Personal Items at School

We kindly ask that students keep toys and personal items at home unless there is an educational reason for bringing them to school. Toys can sometimes cause distractions in the classroom and during learning activities, and we want to ensure that our focus remains on creating a positive and productive learning environment for all students. *If a toy is at school, it will stay in your child's backpack until it is an appropriate time for them to use it.*

This does not include items brought for a specific purpose, such as **Show and Share** or other planned classroom activities.

We understand that students may occasionally bring a toy to play with at recess or on the bus. If this happens, we ask that:

- Toys are **not of significant value**
- Toys are **not traded or exchanged**
- Toys remain in your child's backpack during instructional time

Mobile, Smart, and Personal Devices in K-5 Schools

As a reminder, personal devices such as cell phones, smart watches, and tablets are **not permitted for use during instructional time** in K-5 classrooms. These devices can be distracting and interfere with learning. If students bring them to school, they should remain in backpacks and turned off throughout the day unless specifically approved by a teacher for educational purposes.

Please note that the school is **not responsible for lost or stolen items**.

Please note: Parents in Junior Kindergarten wishing to register in either English or French Kindergarten for next year, need to complete a new registration for their child.

For Families New to FSD:

- [Visit our online registration portal](#)
- Click "Create Account". Once created, you will receive an activation email. You must activate your account to proceed - ***please keep your account credentials handy as you will need them to access your child's learner profiles, pay school fees and sign online consent forms in the future!***
- Upon login, you will be directed to a registration landing page, select the school you wish to register with from the drop-down list. Click "Open" to complete the registration form. You must complete a form for each of your children.
- Complete all the fields and where possible, upload necessary documents.
- Click the "Submit" button at the top right of the screen. You will have the option to download a PDF of your completed form.
- Your registration is now complete.

For Existing FSD Families:

- Login to your Edsembli Family Portal at [edsembli SIS](#) with your username and password.
- Click on *New Registration* and submit your child's information.

What you will need:

- Proof of child's age and legal name (birth certificate or passport)
- *After registration, you may be asked to provide proof of address*

✔ Action Required: School Fees Due

General school fees (outside of field trips and extracurricular activities) need to be paid as soon as possible. If you haven't had a chance yet, please log into your parent [Edsembli account](#) to make your payment. Partial payments are available, so you may choose to spread the cost over a few months.

If your child joins an EJCS team sport, club, or participates in a class field trip, those fees will be added at that time. Please check your Edsembli account regularly to stay up to date.

Currently, we have several outstanding fees that need to be paid in order to plan upcoming learning activities this spring. **Please make all payments online through your Edsembli account.**
