During the month of **January**, teachers will be completing the **K-3 Provincial Literacy and Numeracy Assessments** with students. These assessments are **provincially mandated** and provide information about your child's foundational skills in reading, writing, and mathematics.

Please note that **these assessments are not part of your child's marks this term**. They are used to help teachers confirm areas of strength and identify where additional support may be needed. This information is considered alongside classroom observations and other assessments to guide instruction.

Assessments will be completed during regular class time in a calm and supportive environment. There is no need for any preparation for families at all. Once finalized, teachers will share results with families only if follow-up is needed. If families would like to discuss results or would like additional information, please reach out to your child's **homeroom teacher**.

If you have any questions about the assessments or the process, please contact your child's teacher.

For Families **New** to FSD:

- [Visit our online registration portal](#)
- Click "Create Account". Once created, you will receive an activation email. You must activate your account to proceed - ***please keep your account credentials handy as you will need them to access your child's learner profiles, pay school fees and sign online consent forms in the future!***
- Upon login, you will be directed to a registration landing page, select the school you wish to register with from the drop-down list. Click "Open" to complete the registration form. You must complete a form for each of your children.
- Complete all the fields and where possible, upload necessary documents.
- Click the "Submit" button at the top right of the screen. You will have the option to download a PDF of your completed form.
- Your registration is now complete.

For **Existing** FSD Families:

- Login to your Edsembli Family Portal at [edsembli SIS](#) with your username and password.
- Click on *New Registration* and submit your child's information.

What you will need:

- Proof of child's age and legal name (birth certificate or passport)
- *After registration, you may be asked to provide proof of address*

Action Required: School Fees Due

General school fees (outside of field trips and extracurricular activities) need to be paid as soon as possible. If you haven't had a chance yet, please log into your parent [Edsembli account](#) to make

your payment. Partial payments are available, so you may choose to spread the cost over a few months.
