Let's make this school year one of learning, excitement and curiosity!












Grade 1 & 2...






Justine Johnson, Grade 1 French Immersion






Grade 2/3

- My family and I live in High River. I have two girls, who are in grade 4 and grade 1. In my spare time I enjoy spending time with my family and being active.















