



Registering for Full Time Kindergarten



School Boundaries




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Kindergarten : If you live **1.6km** or farther from your designated school you may qualify for busing.

Why:

To help students get excited and feel comfortable for school! We can't wait to meet you! To determine if any students require extra support (Early support can make a big difference for Gr 1-12).

What:

The EYE-DA (The Early Years Evaluation Direct Assessment) When:

- ii. Our school will contact you to schedule an appointment.
- 3. Check your email and the TVS website regularly.

You will be given the full year kinder calendar and class assignment (MW or TTh) by the end of June. School supply lists will be posted in the TVS website. First day information and welcome letters will be send out in August.

The Learning Partnership

In the Spring (May or June):

- You will be invited into our school to play and learn with your child. We will engage in an hour of playing games and having fun.
- Families will receive a <u>Welcome to</u> <u>Kindergarten</u> package of goodies to take home!
- We will share more information when we see you for kindergarten screening.



How you can help your child get ready for school

- Read books together every single day and point to the words. Ask questions too!
- Develop fine motor skills (how to hold a pencil, use scissors, play with playdough)
- □ Follow 2-3 step instructions
- Practice letters and letter recognition
- □ Find letters/numbers in the environment
- □ Count with concrete items (toys, rocks, Lego)
- Build your child's self esteem with praise, hugs and listening
- Help your child take responsibility (cleaning up toys, using the bathroom, getting their own healthy snacks, dressing and undressing in outdoor clothing - independently)

Supports from Alberta Health Services

Alberta Health Services provides Speech Language (SLP), Occupational Therapy (OT) and Physiotherapy consultations and support for children aged 0-5.

Parents can connect to access a "Speech Chat" with an AHS Therapist by calling: 403-995-2638.

Also, AHS anticipates re-opening their OT/PT/SLP drop-in clinics out of the Okotoks Wellness Centre early spring 2022.


