Mrs. David - Family Liaison

- Family School Liaison Counselor Roles & Responsibilities document distributed.
- Family School Liaison Counselors:
 - o Employees of Foothills School Division.
 - Work full time from larger schools, as Mrs. David does for Meadow Ridge.
 - Focus on social emotional learning: safe and happy.
- Work is based on needs assessments, observations from teachers or parents, or by self electing students. Three approaches:
 - Universal/Whole Class: 10-12 lessons, focus on strategies.
 - Targeted/Groups: focus on relationships, i.e. targeted recess, January building social skills (8 groups).
 - 1:1: focus on services, includes families.
- Mentorship (focus on learning skills through games)
- Nutrition fund (snacks, breakfast, brown bag, hot lunch).
- Great resource to connect with families first regarding any concerns.
- Trained to assist/assess situations of self-harm. Students are to connect with the office if Mrs. David is not there and another support would be called in.



Trustee Update - Sharon Nichols

- Partial review of <u>December 2023</u> Footnotes Newsletter
 - o Bussing conversation has been delayed for another year as per the Minister.
 - Executive review on school boundary report
 - Population has gone down, not up. Not enough information at this time, boundary review delayed until next year at the earliest.
 - Discussion about kindergarten and full time kindergartners at other schools transitioning to Meadow Ridge for grade 1.
 - Should know by February about whether or not there will be a new High School.
- Review of January 2024 Footnotes Newsletter
 - New Foothills School Division app "Stay Connected".
 - Division Wide Student Code of Conduct process under way. Linked to "A Place for All," inclusive space for everyone.
 - 5 Year Education Plan
 - Same strategic goals so everyone knows where we are going. Will assess how things are going and tweak as necessary.
- Board Meeting: Continuum of Supports.

Meadow Ridge Administration Update - Rebecca Forchuk

- CTF Christmas Market was a big success. Raised \$3500 for future markets and literacy resources.
- Read-a-thon started this week. Next week will be spirit days.
- Supports
 - Collaborative Response Meetings (CRM) to brainstorm strategies of support for those who need it. Teacher commitment to those strategies.
 - Hiring an E.A.
- Kindergarten Open House begins in February.
- February 15th learn profiles will be emailed out.
- Portable Update:
 - Commitment from contractor to be up and running at the end of January.
 - Fire alarm did occur but through quick assessment it was deemed safe to not evacuate children into -40 weather.
 - HTA or DMG would be secondary muster points in the event of extreme weather if evacuation was required.
- Safety for All Survey Report distributed.
 - Discussion about increased peace officer presence and staggered dismissal when busses aren't running.
