Trustee Update - Lisa Penzo

- Review of March 2024 Footnotes Newsletter.
 - Focus on Artificial Intelligence and Education.
 - o Ethical use, such as use of chat gpt is referenced
 - There are numerous tools to explore
- Provincial budget meeting
 - No funding breakdown yet for Foothills School Division but expecting less than last year due to lower enrollment and a rolling rated average.
- Funding for design of a new high school has been approved
 - Planning stage complete, now in the design stage (architects, infrastructure)
 - Historically, parent, teacher, and student input is considered by the board for design
 - Parents inquired about whether approval for the high school will reopen the boundary discussion.
 - A few considerations will come into play but the first consideration will be what is released.
 - Parent inquired about length of design stage
 - Each stage is approximately 1 year. Total process ranging 3-5 years.

- Safety for All Handout
 - Common concerns: parking lot, after hour access
 - o Possible solutions: increased lighting/signage, gates, flow change, extra cameras
 - o Group discussion about possible implications of new high school parking lot
- Learner profiles
 - Used to be emailed home.
 - Now, log into edsembli and download the pdf.
 - Group discussion about the difficulties (can't access from cell phone, difficult to navigate) / ease of use (having all children in one place)
- Student conferences
 - Should they be teacher/parent or student-led?
 - Mixed responses.

 - Question if both could be available but this is logistically challenging due to the nature of each type.
