- Summer updates



- July 23rd, Foothills School Division (FSD) received increased funding: 1.1% in base funding, 2% for targeted programming. \$738 K division wide. Meadow Ridge benefitted with a 1.5 Educational Assistant.
- Mental health funding extended Sep. to Jun. (rather than Dec.). \$123 K.
- Received mandate from Minister for Code of Conduct related to device use.
- Review of September 2024 Footnotes Newsletter.
 - Focus on: Support "A Place for All", Advocacy "Contributing to a Flourishing Society" -<u>nominate</u> individuals who have made a significant contribution.
- Universal Screening (K-3)
- FSD App Download for access to current/relevant information

- DMG initiative Grant Writing (learning opportunity) Received grant for "Trickster"
- Summer School 525 students, 700 courses

 - Parent raised concern about commentary on social media about capacity at Meadow Ridge. Debbie responded that the claims are unfounded.
- Parent question If the problem exists in elementary/jr. high (high school concerns will be addressed with build of the new high school) then why are we waiting on the high school?
 - Trustees can add this concern to the next agenda
 - Policy 12 School Configurations, exists to advocate

Meadow Ridge Administration Update - Debbie Payne and Lauren Frandle

- Alison Stewart, the other principal, is on leave until October
- Policy 110 School Councils, how the administration will interact with SC.
- 2024-2029 Education Plan Engagement, support, success
- Mission, vision, values engaged many new staff to revisit and update
- 3B's Review Belong, Better, Best
- Class sizes shared 696 students enrolled grades 1 and 6 have the highest numbers
- Learning sessions: Safety site inspections; Safety and regulatory compliance; Assessment, grading, reporting
- Mobile device use in schools K-6 none, 7-12 breaks and before/after school so far received well by students with no violations.
- Student Matters Student voice with reps from various grades
- Quick glance at AP102 School Leadership
- Inclusive Education Update
 - o Individual Learning Plans (ILP) due Oct. 11th
 - Transition documents built in Spring of previous year and shared with the new teacher one parent indicated that this went very well this year.
 - o An open house for new students, medical plans set.
 - Some delays from universal screeners (40 min 1:1 assessments)
 - There is a survey to capture parent voice
 - Two sensory spaces created at Meadow Ridge \$10K
 - New service dog arriving in a few weeks.
