Friends of Foothills Message to School Councils - Kristy

- Kristy asked if anyone would like to receive emails she receives as chair Haley responded yes.
- Friends of Foothills is a foundation with funding to supplement school initiatives.
- Golf tournament raised \$4,600, 3 K available for schools to apply for a grant until Oct. 25th.
- There is a rubric of requirements to be met (mental health, technology, emergency relief for families, innovative projects etc.). Not to be used for Human Resources.
- Administration has a wish list that the council can use for ideas.

Alberta School Council Engagement Grant - Kristy

- MRS has never used the \$500 per year grant to be used for parent engagement/education.
- Ideas from the past: mental health, technology, drugs and alcohol awareness. Great to leverage opportunities where both parents and students are engaged.
- Can combine funds with another school or would have to supplement if greater than \$500.
- Kristy requests parents bring ideas forward at the next council meeting.

Trustee Update - Lisa Penzo

- Review of October 2024 Footnotes Newsletter.
 - Focus on: Wellness & Wellbeing for all learners, Student Orientation to Schools
 Questionnaire (SOS-Q), where to find information / submit complaints and concerns.
- Student Matters
 - Held 2 weeks ago a lot of engagement from students representing all schools.
- Confirmation that mental health grant covers:
 - 2 learning coaches, individual/school based plans, and a school psychologist across the division.



- High school site has been secured.
 - Out for tender with architects. Hoping for an announcement in February. Packaged with Calgary and Airdrie. Advocacy letters are available on the FSD website.
- New "door to door" bussing walk limit
 - Will be in effect September 2025. Would mean 1.5 million just to purchase 10 buses (exclusive of operational costs). Advocacy letters currently being drafted.
- School Website / Social Media Alignment
 - Currently under review. Consideration for security/monitoring. Will impact school councils.
 Still sorting through the details.
- Boundary Review Engagement Survey
 - Should the review be conducted now or later? Recommendation will be discussed at the next board meeting in a few weeks.

Lisa will bring more information to the next council meeting.
 - Parent question about how the decision will be made Lisa responded there are many factors to be taken into consideration including the survey.
- Parent question on how to express concerns about budgeting answer is write advocacy letters and book 1:1 meetings with the MLA.

Meadow Ridge Administration Update - Debbie Payne, Lauren Frandle, Allison Stewart

- Policy 110 School Councils, how the administration will interact with SC.
- <u>2024-2029 Education Plan</u> available on <u>MRS website</u> (Our School→Education Plan)
 - Drew attention to the Key Insights from 2023 AERR
 - Administration is working alongside trustees and the board on wellness/wellbeing initiatives. Identified areas for growth including:
 - Best place to start is with each individual student in the classroom
 - Focus on continuous support: Shared pyramid of universal, targeted and 1:1.
 - Parent question if support is initiated by teacher or parent answer is teacher.
- PD Day Sep 27th Class profile / review. Engaged teachers from all classes to provide feedback on areas of strength and growth opportunities.
 - o Identified:
 - What is going well for each student? What are their stretches?
 - What is currently in place to support?
 - What are the goals moving forward?
 - Common areas for growth: Social emotional learning, self-regulation, building empathy, communication, numeracy, literacy
 - Parent question if teachers are buying in answer is that all of these strategies are only just starting to be introduced universally. Great engagement so far from teachers.
