BRIDGING THE SILOS

This June, agencies from across the Foothills region will convene to consider and collaborate on youth mental health and wellness resources. As we continue to understand the breadth of mental wellness within our communities, the 2023 Youth Mental Wellness Summit will address the questions brought forward from last year's Summit. Questions include the state of youth mental wellness in our community, how community and recreational activities impact youth mental health and wellness, what are the resources available for our youth, and how can we bridge the gaps in service. There will also be an opportunity for identifying the stories of resilience from our community.

The Youth Mental Wellness Summit will be facilitated by Mark Frezell, a Calgary-based author and executive coach. Together, local agencies and key perspective holders will build a pathway of resilience that is meaningful and accessible to our youth. Youth voice will be leveraged outside of this event through focus group activities to best engage our target demographic.
