IMPORTANT - CHANGE IN TRAFFIC FLOW

Please be advised that BRT Construction is in the process of installing new underground facilities on Behalf of TELUS along 32nd Street.

Soon they will be moving to Chinook Arch Way intersection to complete construction.

This will affect the entrance to our school.

They are in the process of establishing traffic control at the entrance of the school and will provide us with notice as to how this is going to look for your School Bus Drivers, parents, and students.

Construction will be approximately seven days including the weekend, pending weather. The turning lane will be closed for the full duration to allow equipment, and open excavation to the road. This is to ensure the safety of everyone.

We will inform parents on a specific date once we know. Please plan your route and departure time **accordingly. This will create delays.** If the weather permits, we encourage students to walk, bike, scooter, etc to minimize traffic.

Important Information Regarding Lice Procedures at School

Dear Parents and Guardians.

As part of our commitment to maintaining a healthy and safe learning environment, we want to share important information about FSD Administrative Procedure regarding lice. Families need to follow these procedures and be diligent to ensure we stop any spread of lice that may occur. Please review the following guidelines:

1. Identification and Treatment:

- If your child is found to have head lice, please do not panic. Lice are common and do not pose a serious health risk.
- Follow the protocols set out by MyHealth.Alberta.ca1.

2. Contact the School:

- If your child has lice, notify the school immediately. We will maintain confidentiality while ensuring necessary precautions are
- A letter will go home to families of that class to inform parents so they can check and take the proper steps if their child has lice.
- Please do not assume the school knows your child has lice. We do not check and rely on parents to let us know. If you do not, we cannot address it properly.
- Read and adhere to FSD Administrative Procedure.

3. Follow-Up Care:

- Regular follow-up is essential for successful treatment. Attend all scheduled appointments and promptly address any concerns with your healthcare provider.
- Keep track of your child's progress and maintain a list of any medications used.
