REQUESTING CLASS PLACEMENTS:

We are beginning to plan for the 2023-2024 school year. Much of this work is done over the next 8 weeks to prepare for the start of another great year. We have a strict policy when making requests for next year. While we always consider these requests, we may not be able to accommodate it.

Things to consider before making a parent request:

It is the professional responsibility of administrators and teachers to create class configurations each year that balance students' needs and available resources. When making decisions for class placement, a great deal of time and thought is spent creating classes where students will successfully learn together. In order to create balanced, equitable and productive classroom environments, we take into consideration the following factors:

- Class size targets
- Academic readiness
- Learning Support needs
- Specific talents & abilities
- Gender balance
- Social connections
- Emotional/behavioural needs

We use these indicators to create classes for the following year and confirmation emails are sent to each student's family in August. As Meadow Ridge faculty have a wholistic picture, we are confident in the class lists we create. As such, we do not accept requests for specific teachers but do accept letters of parental concern regarding your child's academic and/or socialemotional needs. Such letters need to be submitted before June 1st of the previous school year in confidence to Rebecca Forchuk, Principal of Meadow Ridge School.
