News/Updates from School Council and Parent Funding Association

Did you know we have two different Parent groups you can be part of at school? Our Blackie School Council meets one evening a month to discuss things happening around the school and receive updates from Mrs. Holt and Mr. John Evans (our School Trustee). Our Parent Funding Association meets once a month to discuss fundraising and plans ways to spend our school funds to enhance learning for all students.

Since January our fundraising group has purchased a new Chromebook cart for the school, suited Regional Band students with new uniform shirts. They have also brought in the Calgary Jazz Orchestra concerts, Rocks & Rings, the Astrodome and supported our 2 Science Olympics teams going to the competition.
