Trustee Report – John

- Footnotes is on FSD website

School Leadership Report – Faye

- Info on attendance data
 - o 42/119 have more than 10% days absent
 - o 12/119 have more that 20% days absent
 - May need to have conversations with some families on how the school can assist in lowering numbers of days absent
 - Issues with kids falling behind
 - May be an indicator that the student is having other challenges
 - o Lates can have a similar impact but are not a part of this data
 - O What parents can do?
 - Establish routines
 - Reinforcing why school is important
 - Still keep kids home when they are sick
- Divisional and school-based learning
 - Blackie's focus
 - Growing strong and competent readers in K-8
 - Decodables vs complex text
 - Science curriculum

- Previous question about yearbooks (Why is the school no longer doing yearbooks?)
 - The school has been losing money on yearbooks over the last few years
 - 2020-2021 ordered 1 per student
 - charged parents through school fees
 - lost \$710 due to parents not paying
 - 2021-2022 only 36 yearbooks were ordered and paid for by parents
 - Lost \$65 due to minimum order requirements through Lifetouch
 - **2022-2023**
 - Did not order yearbooks
 - Must buy the yearbooks through Lifetouch in order to use their photos due to copyright
 - Can order principal's book from Lifetouch with all class photos in it for anyone that requests it
- Parent Question: What was the situation with the post on Facebook about "weirdos asking questions about the school" through the Blackie Community Page?
 - Amy answered
 - Someone was asking what the school is like, even though they don't live in the area/country, was removed from the Facebook group
 - Faye added
 - There has been nothing at the school, no weird phone calls, etc
