Trustee Report - John

- New communications manager for FSD
 - Posting new Footnotes newsletter every month on the website
- June Footnotes recap
 - o Budget has 1 million dollar deficit even with funding from AB ed
 - Funding sounded like a lot but it is split between all school divisions over
 3 years and wasn't quite enough to balance budget
 - o Increased costs due to more substitute teachers and busing
 - o FSD decided not to implement bus fee for students/families this year
 - Next year there is a decreased radius (1 km limit) for busing to schools
 - Need to buy 20 new buses as a result
 - Issues: limited inventory, need to buy used, out of province
 - 18 more bus drivers need to be hired
- Working on getting more parents involved in school councils within FSD
- Working on Governance Quality Standard
 - Set of rules for trustees to follow and rules for the public to hold the trustees to
 - Including school visits, indigenous learning, etc
 - o will be made public on the website
- City of Calgary withdrew application to annex part of Foothills County
 - Good for FSD students
- Opening Day celebrations for staff went well
 - School spirit themed

Admin Report – Faye

- Government requiring grade 2 and 3 literacy and numeracy assessments to be done by the end of September
- The rest of the school will be doing numeracy assessments by the end of October
 - Allows for small group interventions, etc
- Grade 5-6 Senator Riley, Cayley, and Blackie School internet safety talk/presentation
 - Parent evening September 20 about internet safety
- Grade 6-8 flag football has started
- There is a cold/illness currently running through the school
- PD day is on Friday
- Terry Fox run was last Friday

School Needs/School Council Projects

Chromebook cart may need replaced (Faye)

- New batteries and charging technology now
- Old chromebook batteries "bubbling"
- One half/side of cart does not work
- Gym equipment request from Ms. Battrum
 - o Fundraising committee to work on this
 - Gaga ball pits are being ordered in order to use up the playground credit from renovation
 - Still waiting for FSD approval before they can be installed
 - Have playground credit from one swing bay that could not be installed due to sinkhole issue
 - Question about benevolent fund for parents in need? (Faye)
 - It doesn't look like parent council has contributed to one recently
 - Some parents seem to remember having one in the past

Younger Grade Extracurricular Activities

- Will be looking into it (Faye)
- Question about cheer continuing?
 - Cheer coach has left the school so this is not an option (Faye)
- If parents have a skill and is willing to step up and run a program, this would be welcome
 - Or older children with teacher supervision
- Parents suggestion to try to use the rink next door for a "learn to skate" type program

Swimming/Skating/Curling (Scott)

- Skiing
 - tricky due to insurance issues
- Swimming lessons feedback from teachers last year
 - o More time spent on the bus to High River than in the pool
 - o Preferred the swim day at Vulcan at the end of last year
- Curling
 - Jill has been looking into setting this up for January

Band Grade 7/8

- Follow up about grade 7/8 issues with band last year
- Scott arranged for Calgary Jazz Orchestra to help with 7/8 band, if the school is interested
 - Has put them in contact with Dylan Wiest
 - They offered to come do a concert for the kids, to come out and work with them, to play the music that they will be working on this year
- Grade 6 class seems excited about band this year so far (Faye)

Next meeting is AGM

- Election of council executive if anyone is interested in stepping up

Stem Club (Scott)

- Scott could do projects with the kids after school a couple times a year
- This was done in the past before the pandemic, but has not restarted
- Will busy schedule, would really appreciate other parents/support or help if anyone has expertise in this area

CTF Discussion and Parent Questions

- Junior high did shop projects last year
 - Hope this continues this year
- They have a classroom for CTF here at Blackie with some equipment
- Look into doing Skills Canada/Alberta again in December (Faye)
