- School councils are mandated

Trustee Report – John

- John takes the things that we are advocating for back to the board and to the MLAs
- Increase in \$850000 in funding for the school year
 - Big chunk (\$150000) of this is extending the mental health grant to the end of the school year instead of ending at the end of December
 - Will put this back into EAs and teachers
 - Blackie will see a slight increase in EA hours out of it
- 15 students from France coming to school division for 2 weeks in October
 - Exchange kids from Highwood in the spring
- AP350 regarding cell phone policy in classrooms
 - Feedback from teachers is positive so far
- First responder program over summer (earning 10 credits for CTS)
 - Was for high school students within division
- Students participated in RAP in the division
 - Working in communities throughout the summer

Admin Report – Faye

- School leadership report
- Chromebook report
 - There are 76 chromebooks for 108 students
 - However younger kids are not using them and the school also has ipads for use for the younger kids
 - About 1:1 ratio for kids that are using them
 - About 6 are getting swollen batteries, will probably need replaced next year
- Areas of focus
 - Literacy interventions
 - Math assessment that drives deep and transferable learning
 - Trauma-informed practice
- Objectives
 - Literacy intervention blocks
 - o Use and develop rich math assessment tasks that help us drive our instruction

- To educate parents around what is trauma
- PD day teacher learning plan
 - Dr. Shelley More this month, Sept 28 at Highwood
- Bulldog Buffet October 4
 - Feed entire school once/month to help build community

Parent Question: What is the mental Health Classroom being housed at Senator Riley School?

- The CASA classroom
 - Partnership with the Government of Alberta
 - Students receive individual and group therapy, psychiatric care, medication and schooling with small class sizes

Parent feedback on issues that they are having with Edsembli website for report cards and paying school fees.
