We need to plan to have multiple adults available to roll them up after the dance is finished. Do we want more 3D print sales? Shannon will contact Mr. Keller.
 - b. Read-a-thon will now be April 28-May12. We will need volunteers. Izabel and Katy said they could help.
 - c. Colour Run moved to Friday May 22. Need to advertise the week of March 22 and get orders before Easter Break. Possibly at the dance. Kristi is going to ask Millarville about their run.
