

myPass – Instructions to Create your Online Account

myPass.alberta.ca is a secure self-service website for Alberta Students. **All high school students are required to sign up for this account and to be aware of their credit count.** It will enable you to:

- Order high school transcripts
- View diploma exam marks
- Register to write or re-write diploma exams (with online payment)
- View and print Detailed Academic Reports (DAR)
- View progress towards a high school diploma
- View/Update your personal information

Before you begin, you will need to have your Alberta Student Number (ASN), a personal email address, and your correct mailing address on file with Alberta Education. *****If you do not know your Alberta Student Number please look on an old report card, your school ID, your Edsembli account or use the ASN Lookup Tool <https://learnerregistry.ae.alberta.ca/Home/StartLookup>**

Instructions:

1. Type myPass.alberta.ca in your browser.
2. Click on “Sign in with Education Account” >> – see below



3. Either sign in with your Google email & password /Microsoft email & password /Government of Alberta username & password and go to step 7

OR

4. Fill in your email. **DO NOT use your school email. Use a personal email address** you will still have after you graduate.
5. Click “I’m new, sign me up!”

6. Click “SIGNUP”. You may be prompted to check your email for a confirmation link after you have created your Education Account. Please don’t lose your log-in info. It is not easy to reset.



7. Fill in the required information. Please capitalize your Postal Code. **Leave the signup Access Code blank.** Then Click “Activate Connection”.

***Remember to use your ASN (only available on your report card – check Desktop version of PowerSchool for this or the ASN Look up Tool on D2L).


Personal Information Management

8. This is where Alberta Education is updating its process. It may prompt you to check an email for an access code or give you other options to complete your My Pass. **If you only get the option of “By your School” please contact your academic advisor.**



9. You will need to wait for Alberta Education to send you a Signup Access Code. **Codes are time sensitive so please finish setting up your account right away (steps 10 - 13).**

10. Go to myPass.alberta.ca like in step 1 above. Click Sign in with Education Acct.



11. Sign in to your account the same way you did in step 3 or 4 above. Either with your Google/Microsoft/GOA username/password or email/password you created before.



12. This time you will enter your Signup Access Code.

Third Party Access

Parents/Guardians may access your myPass account as well. The process looks the same, however the third party will use their own email to create an account. They will need to provide the student's Alberta Student Number and date of birth upon registration. This account will only be accessible until the student turns 18 years old. <https://learnerregistry.ae.alberta.ca/Home/StartLookup>

What can I use my Account for?

Detailed Academic Report

Your main page on myPass will look like this once you have logged in. Select **"Detailed Academic Report" (DAR)**. Click on that and you will then be able to Download it as a PDF. This will be your unofficial transcript. It shows your course history, your marks, your credits earned, essentially a complete snapshot of your academic history beginning from Grade 10.
