2. Log in to your account or continue as a guest
3. Select **“Student ID”** (You can find your child's Student ID number at your Edsembli Family Portal under your child's photo)
4. Enter your **school's name, province, and postal code**
5. Click the blue **“Continue”** button
6. Enter your child's:

- Full name
- Student ID number
- Your relationship to the student

7. Click **“Find Student”**

8. When the photo appears, click **“Yes, this is my student”**

9. Choose from available **photo package options**
