Attendance and Absence Procedure

It is important to know if students are leaving school in case there is an emergency. Everyone must be accounted for. Meadow Ridge is a closed Campus which means students are expected to stay on the school grounds during lunch.

To leave school early, parents should notify their child's teacher of the time they will need to be pick up their child and the teacher will send them down to the office to sign out prior to pick up.

To call in an absence, you have two options:

- Call the school and leave a message on the attendance line: 403-995-4808 – Press 1 for attendance

E-Bikes and E-Scooters Reminder

As a reminder, for everyone's safety, **all bikes, scooters, e-bikes, and e-scooters must be walked while on school property and are not to be ridden on school grounds.** We have noticed an increase in the use of high-speed e-bikes and e-scooters around the school, and we want to ensure a safe environment for all students, staff, and visitors.

We encourage families to review the Town of Okotoks Municipal Enforcement video, "E-dirt bikes and e-scooters: Know the rules before you ride," which outlines what types of e-bikes and e-scooters are permitted, what is not allowed, and how to ride safely and responsibly in our community.

The Town notes that some high-powered e-dirt bikes are not legal for use on roads or pathways and encourages riders and parents to understand the regulations before heading out.
