SCHOOL EVALUATIONS

Background

Evaluations will be designed to assist schools to establish and maintain appropriate instructional, program and management standards.

Procedures

- 1. The Superintendent is responsible for the evaluation of schools depending on need and the availability of resources.
- 2. The evaluation may include a review of stakeholder satisfaction, student success, staff competence, facility adequacy, program quality, support services or any other factor deemed necessary.
- 3. The Principal shall, within sixty (60) calendar days of the receipt of the evaluation report, provide a written action plan which effectively addresses the recommendations contained in the evaluation report. The Superintendent shall set the format for the action plans.
