GET A HEAD START ON YOUR POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION

Histoire, fondements et théorie de l'apprentissage scolaire (EDU F 245) will introduce students to the study of schools of thought and major theoretical trends that have influenced education.

PROGRAM BENEFITS

This is a jump start on your post-secondary education while you are still in high school:

- Earn high school credits *and* post-secondary credits:
 - 5 Credits (CTS 30 level), plus
 - 3 Credits (Post-Secondary)
- Experience what it is like to be in a post-secondary class and learn from experts in the field

THIS IS FOR STUDENTS WHO ARE

- In Grade 11 or 12 during participation in program
- Are keen to experience a post-secondary course through an online format
- Have completed (or are on track to complete) the following required courses:
 - French Language Arts 20-7 or 20-2 and have a minimum grade of 80%
 - English Language Arts 70-7 or English Language Arts 70-2 and have a minimum grade of 60%

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- Online, synchronous courses are live with the post-secondary instructor. They run at set times and attendance is *required*.
- Students must meet all course assessment deadlines in order to be successful (assignments, tests, exams).
- Students must be registered as a full-time student, taking at least one course at their home high school during the program (work experience excluded).
- Students will be expected to communicate with both their FSD supervising teacher and course instructor regularly.
