COURSE CHALLENGE

Background

A course challenge process shall be available to senior high school students who feel they have already acquired the expected knowledge, skills and attitudes for a senior high school course, as specified in the Program of Studies, and are ready to demonstrate that achievement through a formal assessment process.

The Superintendent or designate is responsible for the administration of this administrative procedure.

Procedures

- 1. The process and procedures for course challenge shall comply with Alberta Education regulations as detailed in the current Guide to Education.
- 2. Each high school Principal shall develop course challenge procedures and appropriate course challenge assessment processes.
- 3. Each high school Principal shall establish procedures to communicate to parents and students the availability of and procedures for, course challenges.
