 Hold and talk to your baby; smile and be cheerful while you do. Start regular routines for sleeping and feeding. Pay close attention to what your baby likes and doesn't like; you will know how best to meet his needs and what you can do to make your baby happy. Copy your baby's sounds. Act excited and smile when your baby makes sounds. 	 Put toys near your baby so that your child can reach for them or kick with feet. Put toys or rattles in your baby's hand and help him to hold them. Hold your baby upright with feet on your lap, and sing or talk to your baby as they "stand" with support.
