WHAT ABOUT THAT NEW HIGH SCHOOL FOR OKOTOKS?

Foothills School Division was awarded **design funding** in the 2023-2024 budget for a new high school in Okotoks. With Alberta Infrastructure leading the design meetings, the Board is taking steps to ensure FSD is ready for when **construction funding** is announced.



SO WHAT ARE WE WAITING FOR?

The **green light!** As the local decision-making authority, the Board of Trustees' work begins when the provincial decision-making authorities complete their work and invite us in.

HAVE YOUR SAY ON THE NEW BUILD

As partners in education you can make a big **impact** by sharing your voice to advocate for approval of construction funding. This includes sending letters to high-influence entities like the Minister of Education and your MLA.

The design, programming, and name of the facility will be evidence-informed based on your participation in engagement opportunities. FSD will conduct surveys and events to gather your feedback, once we are able to proceed with the facility planning process.

Parents & guardians were active partners in their child's learning in October.

Every month, our Learning Services team sends a friendly reminder to families to check their child's gradebook. These reminders result in a 16% increase in activity on our student information system, Edsembli. Regularly communicating with your child's teacher, and being aware of a learner's successes and challenges, is just one way to make informed decisions about your child's education.

INFORMING EVIDENCE-BASED DECISIONS

Parents and guardians inform decisionmaking through their participation in assurance surveys. To enhance the results and accuracy of needs in our learning communities, FSD conducts its own FSD Assurance Survey.

Other measurables, such as the Intellectual Engagement survey, SOS-Q, and even attendance, are analyzed throughout the year, offering ongoing, real-time data for FSD to make informed decisions on a continual basis.
