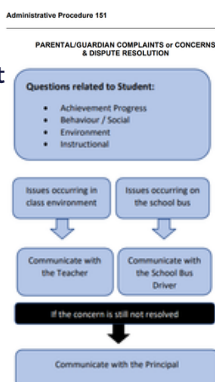
Who do I contact if I have a question or concern?
