1. Daily Writing & General School Supplies

Qty	Required Supply Item Description
1	Pencil case (durable, fits general supplies)
24	HB Pencils (pre-sharpened recommended)
2	White erasers
1	Pencil sharpener (must collect shavings/have cover)
10	Pens (high-quality black or blue ballpoint)
1	Package of highlighters (4 assorted colors)
1	Package of colored markers
1	Package of pencil crayons (24 assorted colors)
1	Student backpack (sized to fit binders and devices)
1	Glue stick (large, heavy-duty)
1	Scissors (ergonomic, metal-blade)
1	Ruler (30 cm / standard dual metric markings)
4	Packages of Lined Paper

2. Notebooks, Binders & Math Tools

Qty	Required Supply Item Description
2	2-inch D-ring Binders (one for LA/Social Studies, one for Math/Science)
3	Coil notebooks (at least 100 pages each; more may be required as term progresses)
1	Graph paper notebook (preferably coil-bound)
1	Scientific Calculator (Note: cell phones are strictly prohibited for math class)
1	Geometry Set (including compass, protractor, and triangles)

3. Physical Education, Technology & Class Contribution Policies
