Now have AGLC certification

AGM on March 20th 7pm foothills school division boardroom, share strategic planning document. 3 members leaving, new volunteer for event coordinator.

Village Report – Lisa Penner – Peace officers are quite busy – 9 days into contract already 30 traffic stops, impact is happening at 20 hours a week of service- stopped by the school and introduced themselves – RCMP turner valley are now being rolled out with bodycams all 11 members will have them. Cameras are on when they are driving or when a call comes on – if you are being interviewed you can ask the camera to be turned off only if you are not the suspected criminal. Longview School Report – Andrea Laubman – budget update spent the surplus paid for bus fieldtrips and chrome book carts, online reading software town of Okotoks pool trip

Kindergarten information night – craft station night, with a Q&A and food and snacks, bring the kids on website and on town information.

Indoor grow op has been purchased eco living wall system – FSD will pay for the power.

Self-contained wall consume everything at hot lunch for salads and fruits. Between grants received \$9700 – total cost was \$4000 – rest will be for outdoor classroom idea. Next week discussions will be with the school board to see next steps and what can be donated who can help build etc..
