

NOTICE OF RISK

General Field Trip

To be reviewed by parents / guardians of Individual (Child) who is under the age of majority.

By submitting Appendix 2, you will assume certain risks and responsibilities, please read carefully.

As an Individual participating in General Field Trip activities, programs, classes, and events sponsored or organized by École Okotoks Junior High School and its affiliated districts, leagues and teams (collectively the “Organization”), the Outdoor Expedition Skills Day activities can include but are not limited to: fire building, shelter building, water purification, tool utilization, and instructional sessions or lessons, (collectively the “Activities”), the undersigned, being the Individual and Individual’s Parent/Guardian (collectively the “Parties”), acknowledge and agree to the terms outlined in this agreement.

Acknowledgment of Risk

1. The Individual is participating voluntarily in the Activities. In consideration of that participation, the Parties hereby acknowledge that they are aware of the risks, dangers and hazards that they may be exposed to, which include, but are not limited to:
 - A. Exerting and stretching various muscle groups;
 - B. The failure to properly use any piece of equipment or from the mechanical failure of any piece of equipment, resulting in injury;
 - C. Abrasions, sprains, strains, fractures, or dislocations from slipping, jumping, falling, or running;
 - D. Privacy breaches, hacking, technology malfunction or damage;
 - E. Sickness, nausea, head ache, and other sicknesses from participating in rides or viewing, including but not limited to roller coasters, animal exhibits, rides, and other Activities;
 - F. Physical contact with other Individuals;
 - G. Not wearing appropriate attire or footwear;
 - H. Failure to act safely or within the Individual's ability or within designated areas;
 - I. Negligence of other persons, including Individuals, or employees;
 - J. Extreme weather conditions;
 - K. Travel to and from Field Trip location;
 - L. Contracting any contagious disease
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
