Registration Process

Our process to register your grade 9 student is different this year than in the past, as we continually work towards improved connection with our future grade 10's. Here is an outline of the process for registering for Grade 10 in 2014:

- 1. Students and counsellors from FCHS/AHSFA will be visiting all our Okotoks area junior high schools in January and February to introduce ourselves and get grade 9's thinking about high school.
- 2. All grade 9's from RDL, OJHS, Heritage Heights, and Westmount will be visiting FCHS/AHSFA for a school tour in March.
- 3. Our open house and grade 9 parent evening is **Tuesday, March 25.** During this evening you will receive a copy of our handbook, a registration sheet, and a copy of our parent presentation for your reference.
- 4. Individual appointments will be scheduled between April 1st and 16th. We will have an online booking system that opens on March 27th. There will be a variety of day and evening appointment options. You will find a link to book this interview on our website http://fchs.fsd38.ab.ca

Registration Appointments
