



Selections for Junior High option courses are now underway for the 2023/24 school year. Instructions to choose options in Edsembli will be sent to your child's student FSD Gmail account. If your child does not have an account, a form will be sent to the email address you submitted upon registration. *Please have them submit their choices by Thursday June 15th at noon.*

While we try to put students in some of their top choices, please understand that this may not always be possible as class sizes are limited. We are using the Edsembli program for Options whereby students are randomly placed into classes based on their choices to ensure a fair process. A wide selection of choices allows students to explore a variety of occupational areas and the fine arts. Students will be choosing options for the full year. Please note there are quarter, semester and full year options.
