With our commitment to safety and outdoor physical education as much as possible, you may have noticed an increase in the number of students outside near the end of the day. For example, when taking a class outside for Phys Ed or Daily Physical Activity (DPA) at the end of the day, the teacher(s) may play an organized game on the field for 30 minutes, and allow students the last 15 minutes for free play on the playground.

In order to remain committed to our safe COVID practices, we ask that parents/quardians who pick-up their child/ children at the end of the day remain at the parking lot until 3:20. Kindergarten students will come out of the school by 3:15 to avoid some of the pedestrian traffic, and other students will be dismissed after that point, but should be coming out by 3:20.
