With our commitment to safety and outdoor physical education as much as possible, you may have noticed an increase in the number of students outside near the end of the day. For example, when taking a class outside for Phys Ed or Daily Physical Activity (DPA) at the end of the day, the teacher(s) may play an organized game on the field for 30 minutes, and allow students the last 15 minutes for free play on the playground.

In order to remain committed to our safe COVID practices, we ask that parents/guardians who pick-up their child/children at the end of the day remain at the parking lot until 3:20. Kindergarten students will come out of the school by 3:15 to avoid some of the pedestrian traffic, and other students will be dismissed after that point, but should be coming out by 3:20. By establishing a routine whereby your child brings his/her backpack to you at your vehicle at the end of the day before heading to the playground, we can avoid the mixing of cohorts during school time.

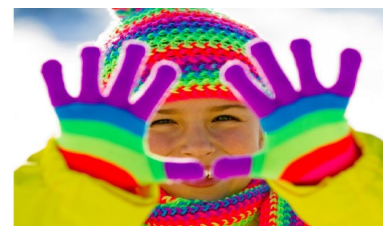

- Only one person per household to come and select the items.
- Two customers will be allowed in at one time. Wait in your car until you are waved in.
- Upon entry: Wear a mask. Hand sanitizer with greater than 60% alcohol will be provided. First names and phone numbers will be collected and retained in a confidential manner for 14 days.
- Know the sizes of the items that you want
- If items are tried on and not taken, they will be placed in a designated bin and left for 72 hours
- If you take items home and decide they are not for you or the person you selected them for, place them in the donation bins around town and they will be returned to the church.
- No children may attend
